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## Entry Notes and Conditions 2008:

- 1. Documentation**

At registration the following documents will be inspected: - Pilot's Licence, Pilot's Logbook, Certificate of Airworthiness & Certificate of Insurance. Marked-up Maps - sheets OS 174, 175, 164, 165, 185 & 186 must also be produced.
- 2. Airworthiness**

The organisers reserve the right to prohibit the launch of any balloon that, in their opinion, is not airworthy. A current Certificate of Airworthiness is required to fly from the event but will not guarantee permission to fly.
- 3. Insurance**

Balloons must carry Combined Single Limit Liability insurance cover in accordance with EASA regulations (EC785/2004). A copy of your insurance certificate must be included.
- 4. Qualifications**

Pilots must hold a valid licence and produce logbook evidence of a minimum of 25 hours pilot in command. (Pilots with less than 25 hours PIC but who wish to attend, please speak to the 3-4-40 Events Team.)
- 5. Pilot Briefing**

Attendance at the pre-flight pilot briefing is mandatory for all pilots wishing to fly from the event.
- 6. Safety**

Any meteorological report or forecast, or other safety or navigational information, is provided in good faith for the guidance of pilots. Officials will be appointed to regulate the inflation and launching of balloons. However, nothing shall diminish the responsibility of the pilot for the safe operation of his balloon at all stages of inflation, launch, flight and landing. He must ensure that his equipment, his crew and his own level of skill and experience, including flying in close proximity to other balloons, are suitable for the conditions in his own judgement.
- 7. Launch Area**

The general public will not be admitted to the launch area.  
Not more than 1 vehicle per balloon may be present in the launch area  
Quick release tie offs must be used for balloons inflating in any launch area.
- 8. Entry Fee**

An entry fee is payable as published on the entry form for the event for all pilots wishing to attend who are not current 3-4-40 members.
- 9. Waiver**

By entering the event, an entrant waives any right of action against the organiser, the owner of any site and their respective members, employees or personnel for any loss or damage sustained by him in consequence of any act or omission on their part, or on the part of other entrants.
- 10. Liability to third party**

By entering the event a pilot assumes all liability for injury, loss or damage to third parties or their properties caused by himself, his crew or his charges.
